- **250 People have completed our form and are registered for swimming**
- **142 People have said they are prepared to pay a small fee to swim**
- **164 People want to volunteer to help save the pool**
- **200 Hours have been permitted. = \$ 10000 in revenue, We need a total of 1000 hours of permits. We are working on**

- **56 people are prepared to donate money to help**
- **\$ 20100 has been raised and \$ 10000 of permits have been applied for towards our goal of \$ 70000**
